6.3 Upgrade Tips


- The upgrade must first be verified in the experimental environment before being implemented in the field.
- The customer's database must be backed up before the on-site upgrade.
- During the upgrade process, once the message that reboot is not allowed appears, please do not power off, reset the system, or plug or unplug any modules.
- There is no need to upgrade the BOOT program.
- The RG-EST series wireless bridges can be upgraded through either Eweb or Ruijie Cloud. This document only introduces the local upgrade steps on Eweb.
- During the upgrade process, please pay attention to the prompt message during the operation. If a failure occurs, try again. If the failure persists, please contact Ruijie technical support.

6.4 Upgrade Steps

- (1) Choose **Eweb > System Tools > Local Update**.
- (2) Click on **Browse**, select the file to be uploaded and click on **Upload**.
